

FCIE STUDY ABROAD SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTIONS & APPLICATION FORM

Thank you for applying for a scholarship to support your upcoming study abroad program! FCIE has a limited number of scholarship funds for short-term and semester study abroad programs. There will be one scholarship per institution, per year awarded to students involved in study abroad. Qualifying students must be degree seeking with a current FCIE member institution. Please check with your Study Abroad office to confirm that your college or university is an FCIE member institution. An amount will be paid directly to the study abroad office of the student's home institution, and prior to the final deadline for payments. No student may qualify for more than one scholarship awarded by FCIE. If you receive or have previously received a scholarship from FCIE, you will NOT qualify again. Deadline to submit application is December 1st-2019.

- FCIE Scholarship Application Form (signed and dated)
- Unofficial transcript showing a GPA of at least 3.0
- One letter or email recommendation from a faculty or staff member from your institution giving supporting reasons why you should receive this award
- Scholarship Essay
