Internationalization Task Force (ITF) formed in January 2011 ITF has representatives nominated by the Deans of all units across campus

ITF has met regularly since its launch

Defining the Plan

Defined "Internationalization"

Identified competency elements and the associated SLOs

Reached consensus on the scope of learning outcomes

Definition of Internationalization

Internationalization is the conscious integration of global awareness and intercultural competence into student learning.

Scope of Learning Outcomes

For purposes of focus and manageability, the ITF has agreed that the scope will be limited to <u>undergraduates</u>.

Students interact effectively with members of other cultures.


