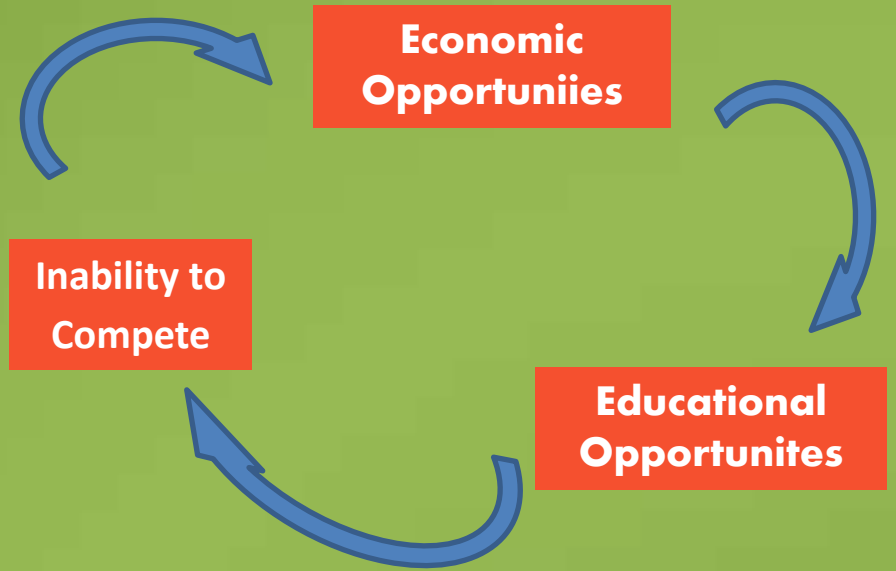

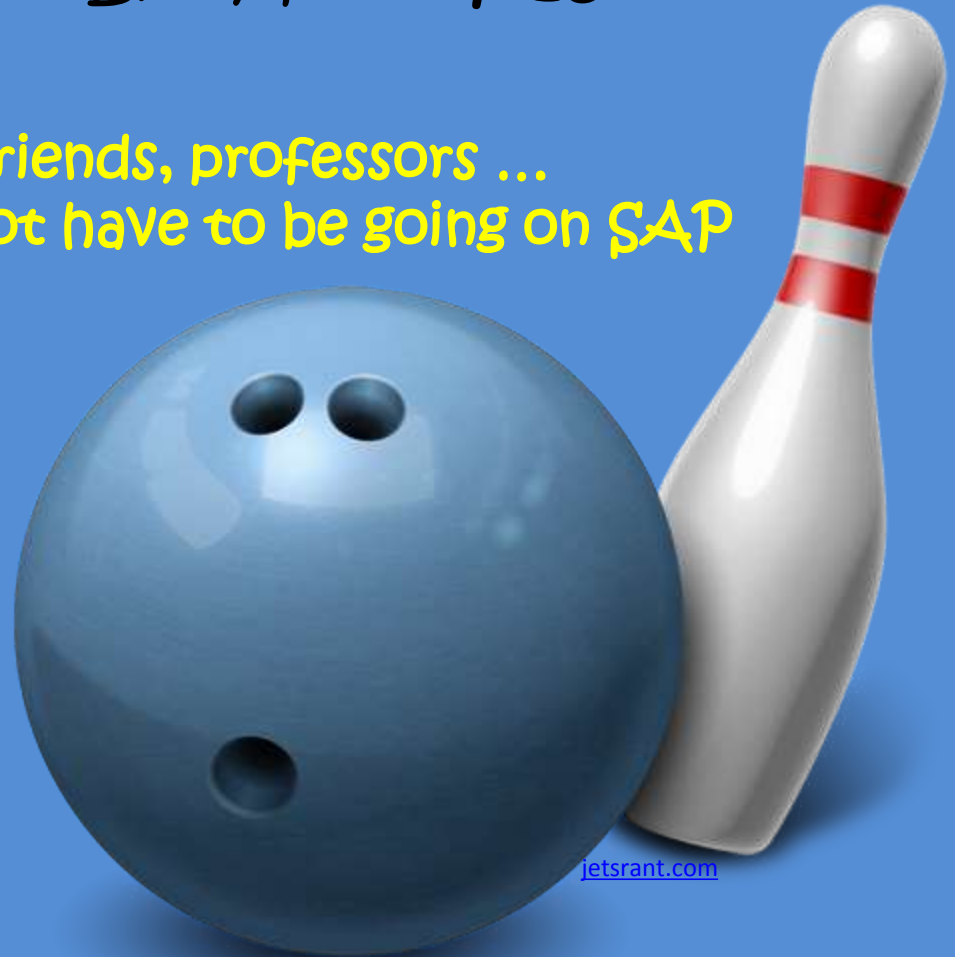
# Bowl-a-thon!

# Maximizing Revenue ...

# Ready to launch ...

**Include any waivers / disclaimers**

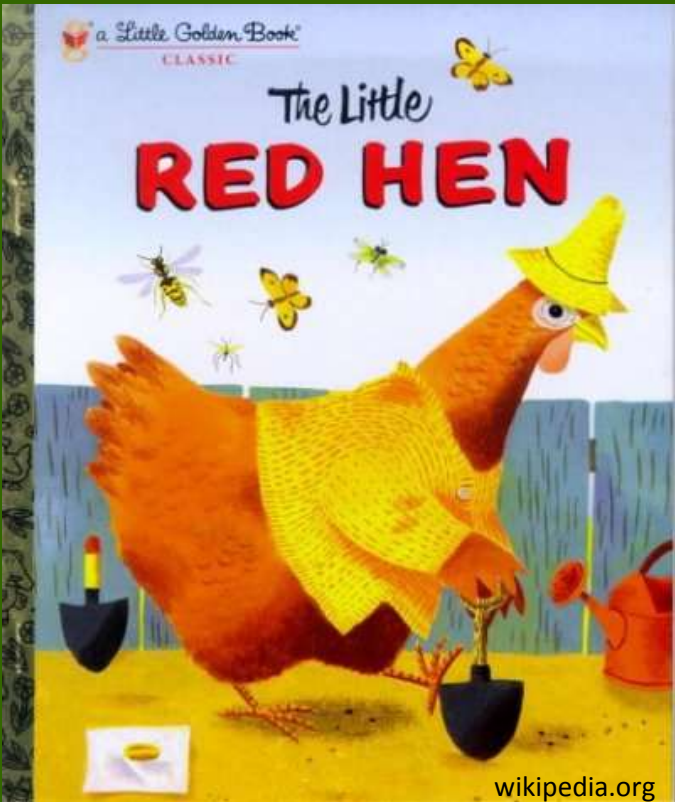
**Follow up meeting with email of powerpoint**

# Division of profits from each project ...

First \$200 to purchase a major prize  
to increase incentive to non-SAP participants,  
future projects

## Remaining profits from each fundraiser ...

50% goes to General Fund	All SAP participants reaching minimum tier
20% to be divided among	Tier 2 earners
15% to be divided among	Tier 3 earners
10% for incentives and/or added program needs	Prizes, future events and/or deadline incentives
5%	SAP participants below minimum Tier

Tier 2

\$500 - \$999

Base Range Tier

## DISCLAIMER:

No participant can receive more than he/she has raised, before final deadline, and then, only after all participants have received full amounts raised in his/her name.

If there are any surplus funds, this amount will go back into the general fund for future disbursement.

Any amounts unused by an individual SAP participant, or division, will go into a general fund to either be:

- distributed among all SAP participants near final deadline;
- fund extra activities or upgrade existing planned-activities while abroad; fund deadline incentives;
- and/or a startup fund to remain in Fundraising account to start next year's SAP fundraising efforts.

# Bowl-a-thon!

## How to increase revenue ...

Help gather donated prizes for incentive ... gift cards, movie tickets, restaurant certificates, theme park tickets, hotel stays, art prints, gift baskets. if you think, "Hey, I would like this." You could have a great prize idea.

Network through family, friends, etc. See if their places of business will be willing to help sponsor educational opportunities.



# Bowl-a-thon!

Step 1: Register! Fill out form, return with \$10 fee

Step 2: Solicit individuals/businesses to sponsor you; use sheet provided to keep track of who and how much! Sponsors pledge either amount per pin, or flat amount.

Step 3: Arrive on-time to Bowl-a-thon event. Have fun bowling! Bring sheet! Notate bowling scores on your sponsor sheet.

Step 4: Revisit each sponsor to collect amount of his/her pledge. The amount per pin, based on the highest score bowled.

Step 5: Turn in all collected funds by 1 DEC, to Valencia Business Office. Prizes awarded based on the following criteria ...



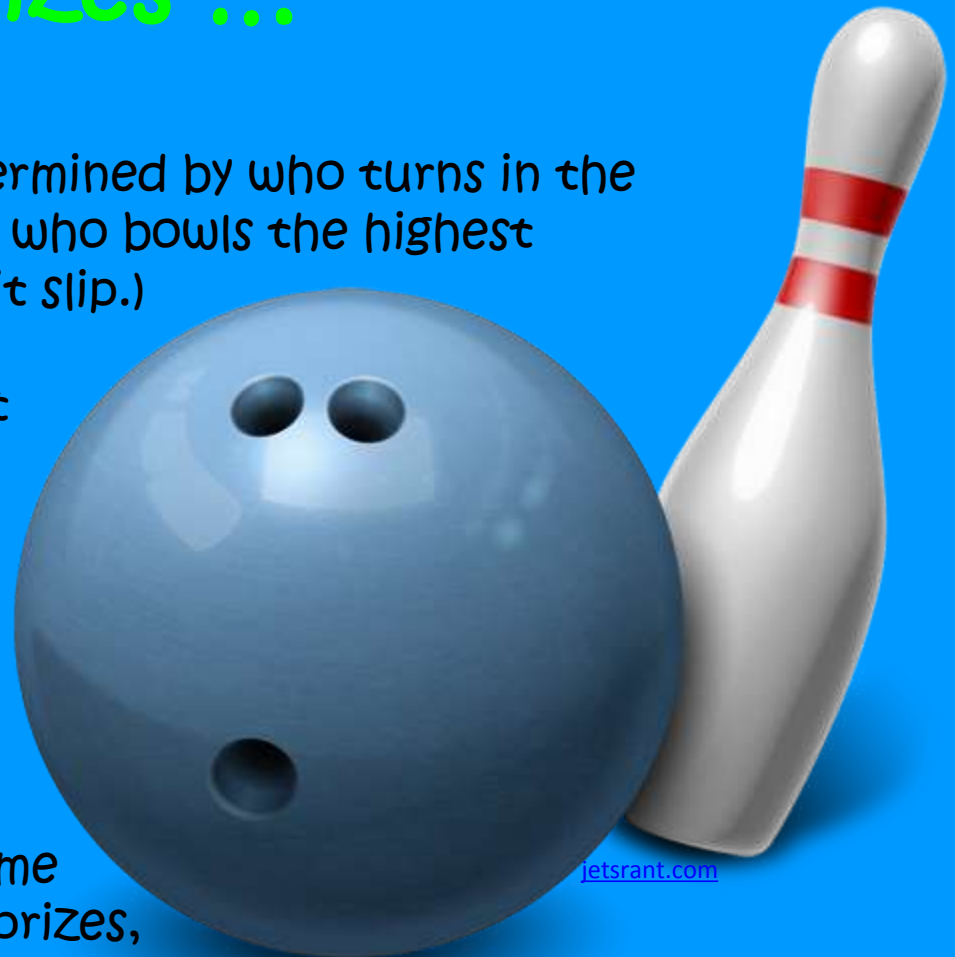


# Bowl-a-thon!

## Awarding of prizes ...

The first place winner will be determined by who turns in the most cash by 5 pm, 1 DEC., not by who bowls the highest score! (See Prof Fowler for deposit slip.)

The person submitting the highest amount of \$\$\$ will achieve first place; that person will select what he/she deems to be the best prize. Then the one w/the second highest amount will select, and so on, until all prizes are awarded. ALL Bowl-a-thon participants are eligible to win; some restrictions may apply to specific prizes, based on criteria set by donation.
