CCIS is a partnership of different colleges and universities that gives access to students who want to study abroad the opportunity to do so through a multitude of programs. As a member we are able to offer some benefits to our FCIE members. Below is a list of benefits our members have access to:

- Eligibility to Join CCIS as an Affiliate Member (\$300/year which includes student benefits and institutional support)
- Student access to CCIS programs at the membership rate, students pay \$400 less per program
 - 100 education abroad programs
 - 27 countries
- Summer, semester, and year opportunities
- Students are eligible for CCIS scholarships, which includes a general scholarship and program specific scholarships
- Access to a community of 100 U.S. and international partners to grow international education opportunities
- Institutional capacity building support at no cost: webinars, trainings, and workshops
- Reduced member conference rates for the CCIS annual conference focused on education abroad and internationalization capacity building
